We need your help! To help us complete our capital campaign and pay off the original mortgage, we are asking you to buy a brick! These bricks will be used in a special circular walkway around the Khatchkar, now being prepared in Armenia that will be the focal point of our Khatchkar Living Memorial Park. This project will be unveiled at the 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Consecration of our church which will take place this coming October. In the years to come, you will be able to bring your children and grandchildren to the “Park” to see your name and their names as a permanent legacy of the Armenian Church of the Holy Translators. You will be able to create your own message or choose from selected designs for your brick(s). These specially engraved, decorative bricks will be used at various places around the Khatchkar. Everyone is invited to buy a brick, either for you or for someone else, to remember the victims of the 1915 Armenian Genocide, or to simply honor or remember a special loved one. What a great way to be remembered and to acknowledge special occasions such as the birth of a child, baptism, weddings, and graduations!

Just **\$100** for a 4”x 8” and **\$200** for an 8”x 8”.

### **Brick Details**

The bricks are 4”x 8”x 2 ¼” or 8”x 8”x 2 ¼” and are engraved using state of the art laser technology. This will

insure strength and durability for many years to come.

### **Deadlines and Info**

September 7, 2008 will be the closing date for Phase 1. This will be an on-going campaign. Orders will be accepted after September 7, 2008 but those bricks will not be installed until Phase two in the spring of 2009. Since we are expecting a large response, please do not wait until the last minute to place your order. We need to prepare each order for the vendor to insure accuracy, and too many last minute orders can hold up the process. Our goal is to have the bricks delivered and ready to start installing by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008!

Your 4"x8" brick can have up to 3 lines of wording and 20 characters per line. (this includes spaces and punctuation)

Your 8"x8" brick can have up to 6 lines of wording and 20 characters per line. (this includes spaces and punctuation)

**Please make sure your engraving information is spelled correctly.**
